1- Welcome

Principal welcomed parents and chaired the meeting.

2- Role Governing board

Governing Boards are comprised of parent representatives, teachers, support staff, parents and member of the community . In order to serve on the Governing Board, parents may not be employed by the EMSB in the school where they are running. The terms are of a 2-year duration with half of the positions coming up for election each year. The Governing Board normally meets each month, the day of the week and time being determined by the members once the board is formed.

On the Governing Board agenda are topics and issues related to the educational project of the school and to the well-being of all its students. Members are expected to take an active part in the meetings and to respect the responsibility of ensuring that every decision is made in the best interest of all the students. Of the elected Governing Board parent members, one parent will also be the representative to the EMSB Parent's Committee at the School Board.

4- Election of Governing Board Members 2024-2025
