Snack Program

Daycare students are provided with a nutritious snack every day after school as per the EMSB Nutrition Policy. If your child has any allergies, please provide them with a snack from home. We cannot guarantee that the snacks are purchased from nut-free facilities.

Homework Program

Students are allotted specific time every day to begin their homework in a quiet and studious environment. Daycare educators are at hand to assist students with their homework and assignments. However, it still remains the responsibility of the the parent/guardian to verify that all is completed.



BASE ACTIVITIES

Fee Structure

The Daycare fee structure is based on a student's daycare status: Regular, Sporadic or Occasional.

Regular Status:

(For a maximum of 5 hours)

A regular student is one who is registered and attending daycare for a minimum of one to five days a week and a minimum of two periods a day. This applies to students who attend on a weekly basis and follow a fixed schedule.

Fee: \$9.50/day (Includes lunch fees)

Sporadic Status:

(On regular school days)

A sporadic student is one who is registered and attending daycare for one period a day (AM, LUNCH or PM).

Fees: \$5.00/morning period

\$1.50/lunch period

\$7.10/after-school period

Occasional Status:

(On regular school days)

An occasional student is one who is registered but does not have a forecasted attendance and does not attend on a weekly basis. Daycare Services are needed for emergency purposes.

Fees: \$5.00/morning period

\$7.10/after-school period

Pedagogical Days:

(For a total of 10 hours)

Regular and Sporadic daycare students can attend daycare on pedagogical days.

Fee: \$15.00 (additional activity fees may apply)
