First Day of School (September 2)

The first day of classes for students in Grades 1-6 is Tuesday, September 2

As a reminder, Bancroft's Kindergarten and Pre-Kindergarten students will start the year following a progressive entry schedule detailed at the bottom of the page.

Regular Entry (Grade 1-6) 8:55-9:05 am

ALL Students in Grade 1-6 may enter the NORTH yard as of 8:55 am where they will be greeted and introduced to their new teachers and escorted

to their new classrooms!

Students registered for Daycare (AM) 7:30-8:55 am

Daycare services are available for students in Grades 1-6 as usual. At 8:55, the educators will bring them into the yard to join everyone

Please complete the Dismissal form so that we know if students are PICKUP or BUS or DAYCARE on the first day

Payment of these fees is due no later than **September 5**^{th,} **2025** by CASH or CHEQUE.

There should be TWO separate payments <u>for each child</u> – one for Lunch Supervision Fees and for School Fees.

Cheques should be made payable to Bancroft School and have the child's full name (first and last) indicated on the back. Parents may choose to pay in installments. If so, cheques may be postdated with any date between September 1st and December 1st, but the full payment must be still submitted by September 5th.
