Kindergarten Sibling Registration (2026-2027)

Parents whose children are currently attending the school will have priority to register siblings in K4 and K5 between **January 12** and **January 30, 2025.** An email will be sent at the beginning of January with a link to book an appointment to register at the main office with the following documents:

- Child's birth certificate (original)
- Birth certificate (or valid passport) of the parent that has English eligibility (original)
- Proof of residence (driver's license, Hydro bill, tax bill, etc.)
- Child's Vaccination booklet (copy)
- Child's Medicare Card (copy)

The official elementary school registration day **for new students who do not have siblings** at our school is February 2ND (with the online booking system opening January 26th at 7:00 am).
