Report Card & Parent-Teacher Interviews

With the month of November comes the end of TERM 1 on November 10. The following week, on November 17th, the Term 1 report card will be published on the MOZAIK PARENT-PORTAL.

As a reminder, The first term is worth 20% of the school year (Term 2 is 20% and Term 3 is worth 60%). You can consult the <u>Evaluation Standards & Procedures documents</u> for your child's grade to confirm which competencies and subjects will be reported on during Term 1. We encourage you to sit with your child to look over the report together and take the opportunity to praise all their hard work and effort, as well as acknowledge the areas of improvement and embrace new challenges.

Parent-Teacher Interviews will take place during the PED day on November 20th (between 9:00 am and 8:00 pm). For the Term 1 interviews, all parents are invited to meet their child's teacher(s) at a pre-scheduled appointment. This year, we will organize the scheduling of appointments using Microsoft Bookings. All the pertinent information you need will be sent home in a separate email in the coming weeks.

Individual Education Plans (IEPs)

If you child has an IEP - The revised document will be sent home on November 17th to be signed and returned to the school. There will be two (2) copies – one for you to keep and the other to return to your child's teacher. During the Parent-Teacher Interviews, you will have the opportunity to offer and receive feedback about the current plan as we begin Term 2.

Parking Lot Safety & Bicycle Parking

We kindly ask for your cooperation in helping us maintain a safe environment in the yard and during school dismissal. Please be mindful to **TURN the handlebars** so they do not cause a hazard to our playing students (see photo)
