Such an amazing job! Bravo to all! And thank you to the teachers for making it possible!

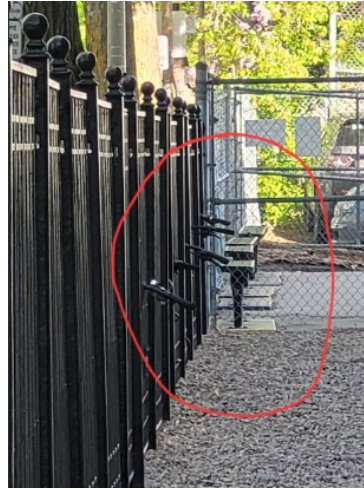
HALO Race

2026-2027 Student Health Form **Time Sensitive**

Last week a copy of the **Student Health Form / Fiche Santé** was sent home with in your child. This form must be filled out and returned ASAP so that our school nurse can review and help us prepare for a safe return to school in August.

Eye exam for children

Doctors and eye experts recommend that all children and teens who go to school should have an eye exam once a year. In elementary school, at least 1 out of 5 students (20%) may have trouble seeing properly. If these vision problems are not taken care of, they can make learning harder. In Quebec, children and teens under 18 can get a **free eye exam**. You can also get up to \$300 to help pay for glasses, if you show your RAMQ health card. Please make an appointment with an eye doctor (optometrist) to check your child's vision and make sure they see well. You can learn more here:
